



Summer Studies in Finland

June 2 – 21, 2017

Application Deadline: February 17, 2017

Each year JAMK University of Applied Sciences welcomes approximately 200 students from around the world for an intensive 3-week international summer school program in beautiful Jyväskylä, Finland. This exciting opportunity is open to all currently enrolled Humber students in good academic standing! Degree-level subject areas include tourism, international business, marketing, and culture and language.

Courses Offered (Degree Students Pick Four, Diploma Students Three)

- Global Team Leadership
- Managing Dynamic Innovation Teams
- Creativity Management
- Global Destination Branding
- Nordic Business Culture and Communication
- Responsible Tourism
- Future Trends in Tourism
- Concept Lab: Multidisciplinary Game Development Project (counts as 2 courses)
- Europe as a Market Area
- Ethical Leadership
- International Business Speaking
- Russian Culture and Language
- Sport and Tourism Management

Program Fee: 360 € per person, paid directly to JAMK*

Included:

- Administration and tutor services. Summer registration fees are waived at Humber for this program. Successful completion of four summer courses at JAMK are equivalent to 1.0 – 2.0 Lower Level Degree Breadth or 1.0 – 3.0 GNED credits at Humber – **must be approved in advance**
- Two night's accommodation @ Eurohostel Helsinki (June 2 & 3, 2017) and group bus travel to Jyväskylä
- Extracurricular activities: ex. Helsinki and Jyväskylä city tours, get together parties, boat cruise at Lake Päijänne, sauna night, farewell party

Location: City Centre – 10 minutes walking distance from JAMK

Description: Shared twin room, bathroom

Includes: Finnish buffet breakfast each morning; internet connection; housekeeping daily; 24/7 reception services; TV in the room

Price: 810 € per person for 18 nights (4-22 June)

Optional study tours with extra fees will be organized to:

- **Stockholm, Sweden** from June 16-18, 2017: **Price TBC**
- **St. Petersburg, Russia** from June 22-26, 2017: **Price TBC**

Not Included:

- Airfare (the cost for round-trip airfare from Toronto to Helsinki should be approximately \$950.00-1,050 CAD)
- Incidentals, spending money, lunch and dinner
- Baggage and trip cancellation insurance
- Travel health insurance outside of the program dates
- Students who are not Canadian citizens may be required to apply for an entry visa for the European Union
- Humber transfer credit fees (\$25.00 per course, upon completion)

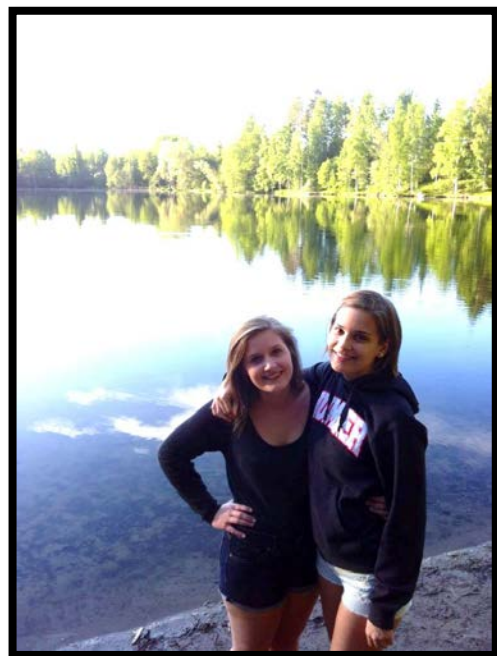

D. Letter of Intent :

A *Letter of Intent* is a part of the application process for the JAMK International Summer School program. Before you start writing your letter, think through first what your objectives and goals are. It is highly recommended that you have someone proofread your letter. You can also get assistance in writing your letter by bringing a draft of the letter to the Writing Centre (it is recommended to make an appointment at least three days in advance).

Your *Letter of Intent* should be one-page in length, single spaced, Arial font, size 10, and addressed to the Selection Committee. Your letter should address the following:

- How the courses at JAMK University of Applied Sciences will enrich your Humber program.
- How the study abroad opportunity will positively contribute to your personal and professional goals.
- How you plan to be successful in the courses offered at the host institution.
- How your experiences studying in another country will help to bring an international/global perspective to Humber and/or your community.

E. Proposed Study Plan:

Select courses of interest that best align with your required Humber curriculum. The credit value of *each* JAMK course is **3 ECTS credits** (European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System) which is the equivalent of **0.5 Degree-level Breadth Elective / 1.0 GNED courses, depending on your program of study.**

Degree Students can select the following:

- "Russian Culture and Language" + "Nordic Business Culture and Communication" to receive 1.0 Lower Degree Breadth Elective credit through LAS in Arts and Humanities category
- Any other two Business/Leadership-themed courses to receive 1.0 Lower Level Degree Breadth Elective in the Society, Culture and Commerce category
- Concept Lab: Multidisciplinary Game Development Project course to receive 1.0 Lower Level Degree Breadth Elective in the Science and Technology category

Diploma Students can select the following:

- All Humber Students: "Russian Culture and Language" to receive 1.0 GNED credit through LAS in Arts and Humanities
- Tourism – Travel Services Management Diploma Students: Responsible Tourism = TRAV 272: The Sustainable Tourism Industry (core credit)
- Business School students only: Up to 2.0 GNED for Business electives (if applicable)
