The focus is a Nordic Noir-styled fashion shoot, supported by film and fashion professionals. It will inspire you to develop your skills and competencies, and introduce you to a new network. Finding yourself in a group of people with the assignment to produce a unique fashion still photo or a short fashion film with the use of professional cameras, models and a makeup artist is an inspiring challenge.

VIA University College will support you all the way with case studies, lectures and feedback, and you will end up with a Nordic Noir result to show, and to be proud to put in your portfolio.

**Program Fee: €980 per person, paid directly to VIA University College\***

### **Included:**

- **Academic Credits: Must be approved in advance.** Summer tuition fees are waived at Humber, and normal tuition will be due for the Fall 2017 semester.
  - **Bachelor of Commerce: Fashion Management:** Upon successful completion of program and supplemental assignment, students will receive transfer credit toward FASH 3001 – Colour and Trend Forecasting

- **Fashion Arts and Business diploma:** Upon successful completion of program, students will receive transfer credit toward FASH 255 Photo Styling and Display Techniques
- **Creative Photography diploma:** Upon successful completion of program and supplemental assignment, students will receive transfer credit toward FOTO 257 or FOTO 218
- Travel health insurance for the program dates, provided by Humber

### Not Included:

- Roundtrip airfare (book your own roundtrip flights)
- Accommodation and meals
- Incidental and spending money
- Baggage and trip cancellation insurance (recommended)
- Travel health insurance outside of the program dates
- Visa to enter Denmark (if applicable – not required for Canadian citizens)
- Humber transfer credit fees (\$25.00 per course, upon completion)

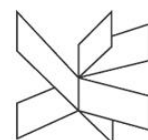
Your *Letter of Intent* should be one-page in length, single spaced, Arial font, size 10, and addressed to the Selection Committee. Your letter should address the following:

- How the study abroad opportunity will positively contribute to your personal and professional goals.
- How you plan to be successful in the courses offered at the host institution.
- How your experiences studying in another country will help to bring an international/global perspective to Humber and/or your community.
