

## Humber College Terms and Conditions of Degree Scholarships

The following terms and conditions govern the awarding and administration of the *Humber College Entrance Scholarships for Direct-Entry Degree Students*:

1. **Applicable Student Credential:** Scholarship will apply to undergraduate degree students.
2. **Type of Award:** Several scholarships will be awarded in values of \$1500 – \$4000 in accordance with the following:

95% +	\$4000 renewable
90% to 94.9%	\$3500 renewable
85% to 89.9%	\$3000 renewable
80% to 84.9%	\$2000 renewable
75% to 79.9%	\$1500 one time

3. **Source of Funds:** Humber College Institute of Technology and Advanced Learning (Humber College) operating funds.
4. **Eligibility:** Newly admitted students entering their first year of post-secondary studies directly from high school, with a minimum of 75% final admission average.
5. **Selection Criteria:** Automatically awarded based on admission averages as calculated by the Office of the Registrar.
6. **Conditions and Criteria for Eligibility:**
  - i. The College allocates entrance scholarships for degree programs to newly admitted students entering their first year of post-secondary studies directly from high school.
  - ii. Eligibility will be assessed based on the grades used to determine the student's admission GPA. The student's admission GPA will be calculated to one decimal place.
  - iii. The student's admission GPA must meet the academic requirements for the scholarship at the time of admission.
  - iv. Academic requirements for the scholarship, and their corresponding awards, are the same across all degree programs.
  - v. Students requiring preparatory courses in their first year or subsequent years of study are not eligible for the scholarship.

**7. Conditions and Criteria for Renewability:**

- i. Eligibility for scholarship renewal will be assessed at the end of each academic year and based on the student's final GPA for each year. GPA will be calculated only on all courses taken during the fall and winter semesters.
- ii. Students must maintain an Honours GPA (80% and above) in order to qualify for scholarship renewal each year. The student's GPA will be calculated to one decimal place.
- iii. Successfully renewed scholarships will be awarded at the same amount that was originally awarded on admission.
- iv. Students must be registered in and complete a full-time course load, unless otherwise determined in accordance with Disability Services.
- v. Students must remain registered as a full-time student in consecutive years for the duration of their degree program.
- vi. If the student becomes ineligible for scholarship renewal, previously awarded scholarship funds will remain as awarded towards the student's tuition fees.
- vii. Any exceptions to the conditions of renewability will be at the discretion of the official designate of the Office of the Registrar. Exceptions will only be considered through official petition by the student's Faculty and on written recommendation from the Faculty's Dean.

**8. Method of Award:** Funds will be awarded in two equal amounts over the fall and winter semesters and applied directly to the student's tuition fee balance.

**9. Method of Application:** Application is not required; scholarship is assessed and awarded on offer of admission.

**10. Selection Committee:** Not applicable - selection is based on admission averages and the above-stated conditions. Qualified students who meet all conditions and criteria will be awarded the scholarship.

**11. Tenable with Other Awards/Scholarships:** Yes

**12. Arrangements for Presentation:** Scholarship will be awarded and applied concurrent with the offer of admission through written notification from the Office of the Registrar.

**13. Calendar Description:** *Humber awards degree scholarships automatically to graduating high school students based on academic achievement. See the corresponding chart for details. Some of the scholarships are renewable each year if you maintain an average of 80 per cent or more.*
